Formerly Incarcerated Leaders to Gather for Community-Building Event in Dallas

"From Prison to Power: Finding Your Voice After Incarceration" Event Will Take Place on April 2, 2022

(DALLAS, TX) – On April 2, a group of formerly incarcerated and justice system-impacted Texans will convene in Dallas. The event, "From Prison to Power: Finding Your Voice After Incarceration," is organized by the Texas Center for Justice and Equity's Statewide Leadership Council (SLC) and partners.

"It's no accident that the criminal legal system isolates us and makes us feel alone," said **Maggie Luna, TCJE Peer Policy Fellow and coordinator of the SLC.** "Whether it's through arrest, incarceration, probation, parole, or a loved one's experience, those of us who've been personally impacted by the system face consequences for years, and that trauma radiates out to our communities and to future generations. By creating this community, we are reclaiming leadership in the fight to dismantle the system that has touched all our lives."

WHAT: "From Prison to Power: Finding Your Voice After Incarceration." A free event featuring presentations from speakers, along with resources and information about local organizations in Dallas.

WHO: The Statewide Leadership Council (SLC), a group of formerly incarcerated and system-impacted Texans who are fighting to change the state's INjustice system. The growing list of event partners and participating organizations include <u>Be Frank for Justice</u>, <u>Color of Change</u>, <u>Darius Pettway Life Skool</u>, Equal Justice Law Group, <u>MOVE Texas</u>, and <u>Texas Inmate Families Association (TIFA)</u>.

WHY: To share stories from formerly incarcerated Texans, provide resources for system-impacted people, and help new and experienced advocates access trainings and community through the SLC.
